

SIGNS OF STRESS IN CANINES

body shaking

panting and salivating

dilated pupils

eyes too wide

stretched face (this is not smiling)

body is tense

excessive blinking

sweating through pads of the feet

restlessness, distraction, agitation

lack of eye contact

yawning

excessive shedding

excessive vocalization

licking the lips or “chomping” sounds from the mouth

hiding behind Handler

turning away

attempts to leave

need for repeated cues

inappropriate defecation or urination
